

Running for Office Can They Run for Office? Escape Room Activity

TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS

Benchmark

SS.7.C.2.9: Evaluate candidates for political office by analyzing their qualifications, experience, issue-based platforms, debates, and political ads.

Activity

Students will complete an escape room activity to demonstrate their understanding of qualifications to run for federal office. Students will answer a series of multiple choice, fill in the blank and scenario based questions about the requirements to run for office for the U.S. House of Representatives, U.S. Senate and President.

Materials

- Can They Run for Office? Google Form
- * Teacher Answer Key
- * Students will need access to a computer with internet access

Instructions for In Person, Hybrid or Distance Learning

- 1. Prepare for this activity by **making a copy** of the <u>Google Form</u> to your own google drive. This will allow you to edit the first section requesting names and class periods, view your student responses, and add any additional questions.
- 2. Have students open the google form on their computer. Before students begin, review the instructions to help them succeed in breaking out of the virtual escape room!

 - Do not use symbols (i.e. ?!+\$#)
 - Only use one word answers (or numbers)
 - Write down each number they unlock as they unlock them. Don't forget! They
